BARKING DOG ORDINANCE NO. 2004 - 1

Adopted May 13, 2004
Effective June 20, 2004

THE TOWNSHIP OF OCQUEOC, PRESQUE ISLE COUNTY, MICHIGAN ORDAINS

ARTICLE I
Purpose

An ordinance to preserve the peace of persons in the township and to prescribe a penalty for the violation of the provisions of this ordinance.

ARTICLE II
General Provisions

A. This ordinance may be known as and may be cited and referred to as the "Barking Dog Ordinance".

B. It is unlawful for any person to permit any dog to cause unreasonable annoyance, alarm or noise disturbance at any time of the day or night, by repeated barking or other sounds which may be heard beyond the boundaries of the owner's property.

C. Penalties: Any person violating this Ordinance shall be guilty of a municipal civil infraction. Penalties will be as follows: First offense \$100 plus costs of prosecution. Second offense \$200 plus costs of prosecution. Third offense \$300 plus costs of prosecution.

This Ordinance was adopted at a regular meeting of the Ocqueoc Township Board on May 13, 2004 and will take effect 30 days following date of publication (June 20, 2004).
